



Grades 3-5 Supplemental Program

Description: This program is designed to supplement your child's educational experience on their remote learning days:

- A certified K-5 teacher (or suitable equivalent) will be on the premises who will float amongst all the students.
- The Study Hall will provide an outdoor guide/leadership facilitator to bring the children outside for **at least** an hour a day. All outdoor activities will take place at Memorial Park (The Study Hall is adjacent to the park).

When:

- If your child is in cohort 'A', they will meet at The Study Hall on Wednesdays (11:30AM-2:30PM) and Thursday/Friday (8:00AM-2:00PM).
- If your child is in cohort 'B', they will meet at The Study Hall on Wednesdays (8:00AM-11:00AM) and Monday/Tuesday (8:00AM-2:00PM).

Facilities/Enrollment: We are accepting only eight students from each cohort. There is the possibility of a ninth student, as one of our rooms can accommodate three students from the same family or two families with a mutual "Covid plan." The Study Hall has four rooms with windows to the outdoors that will accommodate two students each (or a third for the scenario outlined above). You may request to have your child placed with one of their friends. There are two other rooms that will not be used on a regular basis.

Cost: The cost is \$265 per week regardless of attendance. Each week is billed on Monday for the current week. Monday holidays will be considered a school day, and The Study Hall will be open, and bill, accordingly. The Study Hall will be closed for winter vacation and Thanksgiving week. We require a commitment of one semester. A two week notice is required for choosing to leave the program. There is a \$50 discount for siblings (not applied to the first child); this discount is strictly for siblings and not close friends.
