



## The Study Hall Covid-19 Guidelines

- Offering remote or in-person sessions (in-person must sign in and wear a mask).
- Students must have their own materials (pens, pencils, calculators, etc.) and leave them at location if possible. No sharing of materials will be permitted for the time being. If we give out materials (pencils), students will take it with them when they leave.
- Students and staff must sanitize hands when entering the building and between sessions.
- Staff will clean and sanitize high contact areas and any shared materials before and after sessions.
- Students and staff will maintain CDC social distancing guidelines.
- Students will sign a check-in sheet upon entering the building and answer self-certifying questions related to Covid-19.
- Students and staff should check their temperature 3 hours prior to arriving at The Study Hall. CDC guidelines put 100.4° as the universal fever number, but it could be as low as 99.5°. If you have a fever, do not come in.
- Students are welcome to bring in their own water bottles, but food will not be permitted.
- Parents/guardians will not be permitted to wait for students in the building. All parent communication will be through email or phone.
- Staff will make an effort to stagger session start times to avoid congestion.
- Students will not enter the building until 2 minutes prior to their session time.
